Guidelines for Receiving Someone who has had Medical Attention at the Hospital

Please advise Health Care Professionals that the person is a resident of a Residential Care organization (group living environment).

In the event that a person supported requires medical support at the hospital, please follow the process below:

- 1. Upon return home, the person should be monitored for any symptoms of illness and self-isolate for 14 days.
- 2. The person and their support staff should immediately practice proper hand hygiene upon returning to the home.
- 3. Shoes, coat, bags or other items the person had with them should be left at the door until they can be laundered or disinfected.
- 4. The person returning home will be advised and supported to have a hot shower with soap immediately upon returning home.
- 5. The person's clothing including coat, will be laundered in hot water immediately upon returning home.
- 6. The person should have their temperature taken twice daily and recorded on the accompanying chart during the 14 days of isolation.
- 7. In the event the person begins to show any signs of illness, staff will use PPE in accordance to the Routine Practices for Residential Settings Policy R-X-4.
- 8. In the event the person has symptoms of illness Public Health will be notified for further direction.
- 9. The agency vehicle should be disinfected if it was used.
